<b>Scope of performance</b>	Webkit Service (Calendar Service & Calendar Wheel Change)
<b>Version number</b>	
<b>Short description</b>	<p>Through the integration of the Webkit Service on the websites of the repair shops, customers have the possibility to book a repair appointment as well as a wheel change appointment directly at the repair shop.</p> <p>At the same time, Webkit Service helps participating repair shops to achieve greater reach and additional inquiries by directly arranging appointments.</p> <p>The Webkit Service enables participating repair shops to integrate the service search and the appointment booking into their own homepage or into that of the third-party providers.</p> <p>Once a booking has been made, the customer placing the order and the repair shop carrying out the work are deemed to be contracting parties.</p>
<b>Limitations</b>	<p>Calculation of repairs is based on the daily current SilverDAT data, as well as on the hourly rates of each individual repair shop.</p> <p>The vehicle repair costs determined by the Webkit Service can only ever represent an approximate value. The actual extent of the costs depends on many different factors on which DAT has no influence, such as the exact condition of the vehicle. DAT is therefore not liable for outputting a completely correct figure for the vehicle repair costs - it is only responsible for calculating the data bases as entered and made available, in line with the service description above.</p> <p>Third-party data is accepted by DAT without being checked. DAT is not liable for ensuring that this third-party data is up to date, complete, correct and usable.</p>
<b>Access/installation</b>	<p>Prerequisite for the use of the licensed product is an existing agreement with DAT for the repair shop.</p> <p>The prospective customer for a vehicle repair does not need any installation or login credentials to the portal.</p>
